The Memphis Botanic Garden is a beautiful tranquil respite located in East Memphis. It is considered to be the premier garden in the Mid South encompassing over 96 acres of gardens, lakes and woodlands. Included in the 23 specialty gardens are the showcase Japanese Garden of Tranquility, the nationally recognized Hosta Trail, the TN Bicentennial Iris Garden, the beautiful Rose Garden and a level 4 Arboretum.

In 1996 construction of Hardin Hall and the Visitor's Center began. This 5,500 square foot convention center has become home for weddings, trade shows, horticultural events and corporate meetings. The Rick Pudwell Horticulture Center opened in 2006. Three greenhouses and the horticulture building provide the much needed space for horticultural activities at the Garden. This year ground was broken for what will become a state of the art Children's Garden entitled My Big Backyard. Master Gardeners assist the staff in all areas of horticulture and educational activities at the Garden.

March – October Sunday 11:00AM – 6:00PM

November – February Closing time is 4:30PM

Memphis Botanic Garden has 96 acres with 23 specialty gardens, which provide an in-depth look into various families of plants, flowers and trees. These gardens include a Hosta Trail, Hydrangea Garden, Daylilly, Cactus & Herb Gardens, the Tennessee Bicentennial Iris Garden and a showcase Japanese Garden of Tranquility, just to name a few.
